The Latest Rhode Island Salt-Water Fishing Report reads as follows:

Not sure if you guys have heard, False Albacore are in. I have some some fresh news (*the word is not really out yet!*) that the West Wall in Jersusalem (Pt Judith) is hoping, you don't need a boat, just walk out on the jetty/wall in the early AM. I hear about 20 fly fisherman are already on them, but the wall is like a 1/2 mile long and plenty of space. My friend Phil was there twice this week and cleaned up on Albies. Maybe some Bonito mixed in too? If you have time this week, you should get down there & wet a line.

UpCountry Sportfishing website reports that on:

Sunday 9/12/10 - The Farmington River in CT is flowing clear and cool through the catch and release area at 100cfs the water is 60 degrees. The DEP stocked the river with 2,000 trout last week from the Goodwin Dam downstream to Peoples State Forest.

Winter/Summer Caddis (sz 20-24) and tiny Rusty Spinners (sz 20-26) have been working in the early morning. Tan Caddis sz 18-20), Black Ants (sz 14-18), Beetles (sz 12-16) are strong during the day. Flying Ants (sz 16-24), Isonychia (sz 10-14) and Cahills (sz 12-14) have been in the water from 5pm to dark.

MASS Wildlife Reports that:

The Fall trout stocking occurs in a 2-week period, usually beginning in the last week of September and ending before Columbus Day. Due to the short stocking season, the fall stocking activity will not be on this Stocking Schedule. However, if you refer to the State website you will learn which bodies of water will be restocked in the weeks ahead.
