Did you read this past week's On the Water Fishing Forecast for the Cape area?

Freshwater fishing, especially for trout, seems to be approaching its fall peak. Try small spoons for the trout, or if you wave the long wand, streamer flies or dry flies that closely "match the hatch." Serious fly fisherman I am not, but every time I've been on a trout pond lately I've watched the fish almost blitzing under clouds of small black flies. I've tried a number of presentations on my St. Croix Rio Santo fly rod and reel, but have yet to connect on a dry fly. Maybe one of the more advanced fly fishermen on the Cape can let me know what these flies are and how to best imitate them so I can share the information with the Cape Forecast readers next week.

Trout fishing, Dan reported, is phenomenal. All flavors of stocked trout have been ravenously attacking spoons and baits in Cape Cod ponds. Dan had even heard of a few salmon caught. These could be holdover fish resuming their feeding activity as the water cools, or the state may have quietly completed their initial salmon stocking. Either way, fish up to 34 inches were caught and were pleasant surprises to the lucky anglers.
