It is important to note, that since, Whiting's Pond is stocked regularly with trout in the Spring, you will need a MA State fishing license & trout stamp.

This pond has a nice beach area and boat landing area with plenty of room along the shoreline in order to gather and sit while we cook & eat. However, it might not be a bad idea to bring along a portable chair to sit on and some bug spray too just in case. Food will be

provided but, feel free to bring along either an appetizer or desert to share if you are so inclined. In addition, guests & non-members are welcome to join us as the more the merrier for our annual club picnic. Please note, that everyone is responsible for their own safety and that there will be a fly-rod demonstration and rods available for trying out courtesy of Temple Fork Outfitters. If any member has a canopy or tarp and would not mind throwing it in their car in the event of a little rain that would be helpful.

I have been told to inform everyone that in the event of a heavy soaking rain storm throughout the day, the plan **will be to** simply switch the meeting location from Whiting's Pond to our normal meeting site back over at the South Foxboro Community Center beginning at 6:30pm. ### UPCOMING CLUB FISHING TRIPS FOR 2010: FRESH & SALT-WATER

Please refer to the dates found on the Crossroads Anglers website for the various upcoming fresh & saltwater fishing trips. In addition, I suggest that you check in with the Bear's Den in Taunton, MA in order to learn more about their regular Wednesday night salt-water fishing trips to local hot spots beginning May 12<sup>th</sup> and continuing through the Summer.

On **Tuesday**, **June 8**<sup>th</sup> the members of Crossroads Anglers are planning to travel down to Narragansett, Rhode Island in order to fly-fish the Narrow River for striped bass. The plan is to meet at the Sprague Bridge along the Narrow River at 7pm. Or perhaps, you may wish to join a group of us who will be meeting ahead of time at the Triboro Plaza located in North Attleboro (at Exit 5 off Route 95) at 5:30pm in front of the Shaw's Supermarket in order to carpool and drive down together to fish. This will be a nice opportunity to do some wade fishing in the salt-water with good company, learn a new spot to fish and perhaps, connect with a few nice fish too? There will be plenty of instruction available from members for those new to salt-water fly-fishing.

**Suggestions of what to bring include:** bug spray, flashlight, waders, stripping basket, floating and sinking or sink tip line and your favorite 8 or 9 weight fly-rod. A camera would not be a bad idea either as this is a pretty spot to fish even if the fish do not cooperate.

"Its' worth noting that saltwater fishermen in Rhode Island need to either register for the federal registry or pick up a Rhode Island saltwater license. The saltwater license is \$7, and is available only at www.saltwater.ri.gov. Signing up for the federal registry is free, at countmyfish.noaa.gov. However, only the Rhode Island license will be valid in other state waters that have a reciprocal agreement with Rhode Island.—this update is provided courtesy of, On The Water Media Company.
